**Especially to the biggest goat, Bert.**





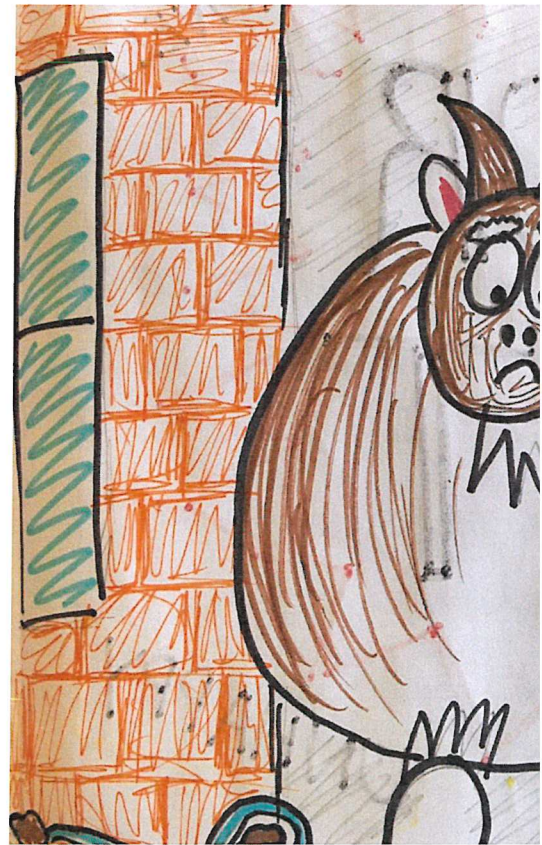

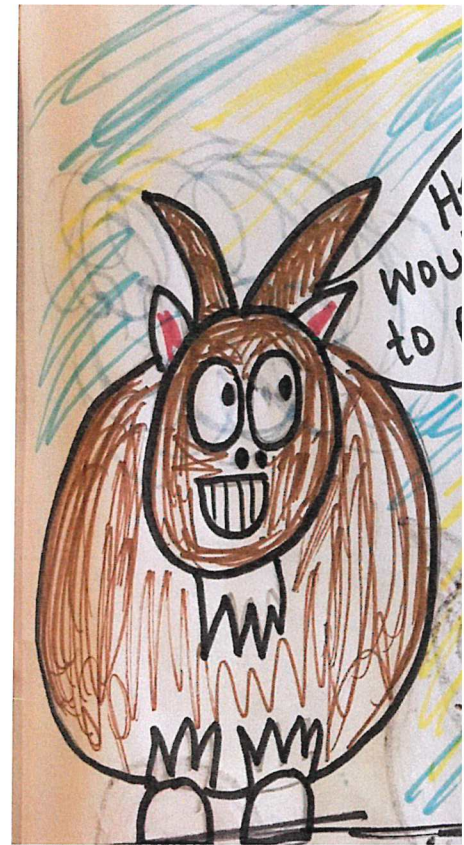




After speaking to him she finally got to the bottom of the smallest problem Bert had been having. The names, like the teacher, looking at him out of the corner of his eye. Bert!


